| 186  | <p>The following content has been updated:</p> <p><b>Personal Protective Equipment at Work (Amendment) Regulations 2022</b></p> <p>On 6 April 2022 the Personal Protective Equipment at Work (Amendment) Regulations 2022 come into force and amend the 1992 Regulations.</p> <p>Under the amended legislation the duties and responsibilities on employers and employees will remain the same but will extend to workers who are defined as limb (b) workers.</p> <p>In the UK the Employment Rights Act’s definition of a worker has 2 limbs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Limb (a) workers describes those workers with a contract of employment.</li> <li>• Limb (b) describes workers who generally have a casual employment relationship and work under a contract for service. **Stress at Work**

In the last decade, increasing attention has been paid by employers, the enforcement agencies, trade unions and the courts to the question of stress at work. According to the HSE. It is reported that 822,000 workers are suffering from work-related stress, depression or anxiety (new or long-standing). In 2020/21, an estimated 449,000 reported that this was caused or made worse by the effects of the coronavirus pandemic.
