11	<p>Current text reads: Data Protection Act 1998</p> <p>This has been changed to: Data Protection Act 2018</p>  <p>Tutor notes have been updated to:</p> <p>In May 2018, the Data Protection Act was updated to ensure the safety of people’s data and reduce the opportunity for cyber-thieves to steal personal data. There are 6 general principles (plus 1) of the General Data Protection Regulation – it is worth researching these (as a tutor) if you are unclear of the depth of the changes. The 6 principles of the GDPR are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Lawfulness, fairness and transparency2. Purpose limitations3. Data minimisation4. Accuracy5. Storage limitation6. Integrity and confidentiality. <p>There is a ‘plus 1’ - 7 Accountability and compliance.</p> <p>Suffice to say that there is a greater responsibility on employers to carefully manage the data they receive from customers and staff. Large companies will have a designated data protection officer, responsible for ensuring the details of the act are followed.</p>

147	<p>Tutor notes have been updated to:</p> <p>Ask the learners what they think a suspicious package could look like. What would an improvised explosive device (IED) look like? What other sorts of suspicious package could there be?</p> <p>This is a pertinent time to ask the stewards what they think a suspicious package could look like. What would an improvised explosive device (IED) look like? What other sorts of suspicious package could there be? At Manchester United, a training package in the shape of a 'pipe bomb' was found after being left by accident after a training exercise. The match was called off when this was found, and 75,000 people were evacuated.</p>
149	<p>Tutor notes have been updated to:</p> <p>During the Paris attack at the Stade de France it was a steward who prevented a man without a ticket from entering – it turned out he had an explosive vest on that he later detonated outside the ground – killing himself and injuring a spectator.</p>
