15	<p>Tutor note have been updated to:</p> <p>The HSE's 'Costs to Great Britain of workplace injuries and new cases of work-related ill health 2015/16' report estimates the costs of injuries and ill health. An average of 614,000 workers were injured in workplace accidents, costing society overall an estimated £5.3bn. In addition, £9.7bn was the cost of illnesses caused or made worse by work. The total estimated economic cost of these cases was £14.9 bn. The majority of costs fall on individuals. Individual: £8.6bn Employer: £2.9bn Government: 3.4bn</p>
